for Wenonah Borough Council



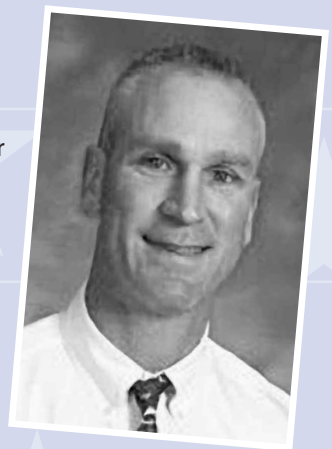
